Past Award Recipients:

- **2020 Pastor Jeffrey Phail** of Christian-Heritage Church in Avon for his work with the Summer Lunch Program. In 2017 he recognized an opportunity to help feed students who faced food insecurity during the summer months. Pastor Phail organizes hundreds of volunteers from to serve thousands of lunches each summer.
- **The Hooks for Hunger Committee** is a group of volunteers who work tirelessly each year to raise funds for CRS through their annual walleye fishing tournament. Since its inception in 2013, this group has donated over \$213,000 to CRS. They have even added more fundraising events such as the King of the Smokehouse and Chili Cookoff contests!
- Mike Kral is a long-time volunteer for CRS and many other organizations in Avon Lake. He has donated his time and talent to CRS; from board member to webmaster and graphic designer. He continues to be involved in all creative aspects of our special events. Mike's unselfish service to so many Avon Lake organizations made him the selection committee's unanimous choice to receive this award.
- 2023 Rich and Candy General have together and individually volunteered hundreds of hours of their time and talents to bettering the community through their involvement in many local organizations. Many of CRS's seasonal programs have benefitted from their support such as Santa's Workshop, Summer Snack Bags, Easter and the CRS food pantry.
